## ANATOMY & PHYSIOLOGY DIPLOMA

The IDTA Anatomy Diploma will be available from 1 January 2008. From 1 September 2008 candidates taking their first Theatre Branch Associate examination (Ballet, Tap, Modern Jazz or Theatre Craft) will be required to provide evidence that they hold an Anatomy Diploma, either from the IDTA or another recognised dance organisation or similar body. Candidates must provide a copy of an Anatomy Diploma certificate with their professional application and include a copy in their portfolio. The candidates will be successful or unsuccessful, the pass mark being 65%.

Candidate must be 16 years or over to take the Anatomy Diploma examination.

Examination Fee for the Anatomy Diploma £55.00 @ 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022. (Examination fees are reviewed annually and take effect from 1<sup>st</sup> September each year, please check the current fee with Head Office).

Examination Procedure:

Candidates may take the Anatomy Diploma at their dance school, another teacher's school or at a Professional Examination Session in their area. Diplomas may also be taken at the IDTA Leicester Seminar and the Annual Congress and London meeting by prior arrangement.

Teachers should indicate on the request form the number of Anatomy Diplomas to be taken, as the exact number of papers will be sent to the Examiner.

Teachers should allow 45 minutes on the timetable for the Diploma to be taken, the actual examination time is 30 minutes, plus 15 minutes for candidates to take and leave their seats and for the Examiner to give instructions, hand out the papers and collect them.

A suitable quiet area of the studio or an office area should be set aside so that the candidates may take this written examination, which is in the form of a multiple-choice paper. Please ensure the candidates will not be disturbed during the examination and that they have appropriate seating.

The Examiner will ask the candidates to take their seats. Candidates will only require a pen to complete the examination. Mobile phones, personal music equipment etc... should not be taken into the examination area.

The Examiner will hand out the Anatomy paper and advise the candidates that they should complete the front page and that they have 30 minutes to complete the paper. Candidates may start the paper when the Examiner indicates they may do so.

The Examiner will advise the candidates when there is only 5 minutes left of the 30-minute examination time. At the end of 30 minutes the Examiner will ask the candidates to stop and collect all the papers, which will be sealed in an envelope (including any unused papers) and returned to Head Office for marking.
